**Directions:** Take MD Route 210 south all the way to its end at the Navy base. **To drop off a boat**: Take last **left** before the base to Mattingly Ave, drive *slowly* 3/4 mile to the creek.

**To park**: Take last **right** before the base to Pye Street, to dirt road marked Lotus Blossom Festival Parking. Park on grass. Use our *free shuttle bus* for the 5 minute ride to the event.
